



## **DURING JULY TO SEPTEMBER 2018:**

- more than 6 million journeys were made across the bridge.
- 96% of drivers paid for their crossings before the payment deadline.
- 77% of journeys were made in vehicles registered with merseyflow.
- over 74,000 journeys were made across the bridge most weekdays, which is in excess of projected traffic levels.
- between 18 and 23% of monthly revenue came from PCNs. All revenue, either from tolls or PCNs, contributes towards payment for the new bridge; it is not retained by the Council or any of its contractors.
